ACCESS LETTERS CONTRACT CHANGE NOTICE: NUMBER 013

DATED: 18 May 2015

This notice applies to you if you hold an Access Letters Contract (Contract) with Royal Mail Group Limited, a company registered in England and Wales (number 04138203) with its registered address at 100 Victoria Embankment, London EC4Y 0HQ.

1. Definitions and interpretation

- 1.1 If a word or expression is defined in this notice, it shall have the meaning given in this notice.
- Any words or expressions which are not defined in this notice, but have an initial capital letter, shall have the meaning given to them in the Contract.
- 1.3 All of the rules about how to interpret the Contract shall apply to this notice.

2. Changes to the Contract

- 2.1 We hereby give you notice under paragraph 13.1 of Schedule 7 (Royal Mail Responsible Mail®) to the Contract that, with effect from **18 September 2015**, we are changing the Sourcing and Recyclability Specification to permit the use of brown paper (including manilla) and/or brown paper envelopes (including manilla).
- 2.2 Paragraph 7.1.7 of Schedule 7 to the Contract will therefore be deleted and replaced by the following:
 - "7.1.7 none of the following may be present in any Mailing Item:
 - a) polywrap envelopes; or
 - b) laminate finishes.".
- 2.3 We are not operationally affected by this change to the recyclability specification and wish to confirm that we are happy to accept Responsible Mail[®] Mailing Items that use brown paper (including manilla) and/or brown envelopes (including manilla) with immediate effect in order to start realising the benefits of this change for the environment and our customers.
