

ACCESS LETTERS CONTRACT CHANGE NOTICE: NUMBER 085

DATED: 22 SEPTEMBER 2022

This notice applies to you if you hold an Access Letters Contract (Contract) with Royal Mail Group Limited, a company registered in England and Wales (number 04138203) with its registered address at 185 Farringdon Road, London EC1A 1AA.

1. Definitions and interpretation

- 1.1 If a word or expression is defined in this notice, it shall have the meaning given in this notice.
- 1.2 Any words or expressions which are not defined in this notice, but have an initial capital letter, shall have the meaning given to them in the Contract.
- 1.3 All of the rules about how to interpret the Contract shall apply to this notice.

2. Changes to the Contract

- 2.1 We hereby give you notice under clause 13.2.4 of the General Access Terms and Conditions to change the allocation of Postcode Sectors to Zones with effect from **1 April 2022**.
- 2.2 The change referenced at paragraph 2.1 above will result in a change to the composition of the Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile for 2022-23 for customers posting on Averaged Price Plan Two (Zones) and the Regional Price Plan (Zones).
 - a. From **1** April **2022**, the Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile for Averaged Price Plan Two (Zones) will change to:

b. From **1** April **2022**, the Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile for the Regional Price Plan (Zones) will change to:

Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile 2022-23	Urban	Suburban	Rural
England & Wales	44.403%	35.950%	19.647%
Scotland	38.210%	35.702%	26.088%
Northern Ireland	21.113%	32.155%	46.732%

2.3 The change referenced at paragraph 2.1 above will also result in a change to the composition of the Urban Density Benchmark for Price Plan One (SSCs) with effect from **1** April **2022**, details of which are published on the contracts page of the Website.
