# Q2 Price Plan Profile Surcharges / Changes to Permitted Variances

Dear Customer

I write with updates on the following matters relating to the price plans for the Access Letters Contract, Wholesale Parcels Contract and C9 Premium Agreement:

- > Q2 contract monitoring for the 2020/21 financial year;
- > Changes to the Permitted Variances; and
- > Allocation of Postcode Sectors to Zones 2020/21.

# Q2 Price Plan Profile Surcharges

Some Wholesale customers have asked us to provide an update as to how, in light of the Covid-19 pandemic, we are dealing with Q2 contract monitoring for National Price Plan One, Averaged Price Plan Two and Regional Price Plan customers for the 2020/21 financial year.

We have previously explained that we would monitor the impact of Covid-19 on customers' ability to meet their price plan profile requirements during Q1 and Q2 2020/21. In September we informed customers that we were disregarding Q1 when calculating Profile Surcharges following our analysis of the Q1 price plan profiles.

We have now completed the review of the Q2 (July to September) price plan profiles and the results from this analysis show that, compared to the baseline profile, the overall/cumulative profile averaged out across all customers looks similar. However, we appreciate this may not be a fair reflection of the impact of Covid-19 on individual customers.

Therefore, we have decided that the most appropriate solution is to disregard Q2 when calculating Profile Surcharges, and (for the purposes of 2020/21 only) to base them instead only on data we consider to be sufficiently robust, which at this time we expect to be the Q3 to Q4 figures. This decision shall take effect under the provisions of <u>Access Letters Contract Change Notice 064</u> which comes into force on 31 March 2021.

## Price plan profile surcharges for the remainder of 2020/21

We fully appreciate that Covid-19 is continuing to cause disruption across the whole mail industry and may have an adverse impact on customers' ability to meet their price plan profile requirements during the remainder of 2020/21. As for Q1 and Q2, we are continuing to review customer volumes during the affected period, to assess any adverse implications Covid-19 may be having on your ability to meet the profile commitments, and will update you at the earliest opportunity

#### Changes to the Permitted Variances for NPP1 and APP2 customers

As you are aware, we are in the second year of a four-year glidepath to reduce the permitted variances (tolerances) of the national price plans and the regional price plan, following proposals from customers that attended workshops in 2017. The previous reductions came into force from April 2020 as part of this glidepath.

From April 2021, we are reducing the tolerances further, as shown in the table below. We are keeping the reductions low to gives customer maximum opportunity to make the necessary adjustments.

National Price Plan 1 (SSC)	Urban Density: 30%	Urban Density: 25%
Averaged Price Plan 2 (Zones)	5.5%	4.5%
Regional Price Plan	5.5%	4.5%

I enclose the formal change notices (number 072 for the Access Letters Contract and number 028 for the Wholesale Parcels Contract) detailing the April 2021 changes.

#### Allocation of Postcode Sectors to Zones 2021/22

We have completed the annual review of the allocation of Postcode Sectors to Zones and there is some movement of Postcode Sectors for the forthcoming financial year 2021/22. The changes affect the Access Letters Contract, the Wholesale Parcels Contract and the Condition 9 Premium Agreement as detailed in the applicable contract change notices attached to this letter. The following changes come into effect from **1** April **2021**:

- (a) A revised Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile for 2021/22, published in the profiles and permitted variances file which you can find at <u>https://royalmailwholesale.com/permitted-variances-and-profiles</u>. We will also update the NGPP Calculator, on the same webpage, to display the new Royal Mail Zonal Posting Profile relevant to each contract.
- (b) A revised **Urban Density Benchmark Profile for 2021/22**, as published in the profiles and permitted variances file which you can find at <a href="https://royalmailwholesale.com/permitted-variances-and-profiles">https://royalmailwholesale.com/permitted-variances-and-profiles</a>.
