- 1 Definitions and interpretation
- 1.1 If a word or expression is defined in this notice, it shall have the meaning given in this notice.
- Any words or expressions which are not defined in this notice, but have an initial capital letter, shall have the meanings given to them in the Contract.
- 1.3 All of the rules about how to interpret the Contract shall apply to this notice.
- 2 Changes to the Contract
- 2.1 We give you notice under clause 13.2.1(a) of the General Access Terms and Conditions, that paragraph 5 of Schedule 23: 48-Way Sort Mech Letter Option shall be deleted in its entirety.
- We give you notice under clause 13.2.3(c) of the General Access Terms and Conditions to change the Permitted Variances used in the measurement of your profile and compliance with National Price Plan One (SSCs). Customers who were previously measured for adherence to the Profile Commitment against 86 SSCs will going forward be measured against 48 SSCs, using the Permitted Variances applicable to 48 SSCs as set out in the document titled 'Letters profiles and permitted variances' as published on our Website.
- 2.3 The changes detailed in this paragraph 2 will take effect from 1 April 2022.
